## Reading & Breakfast Club Needs You!





We were off to a head start the week before having a **Science Buddies** afternoon. Everyone across the school buddied up with another class to complete a science activity together. We had an amazing time making straw rockets, creating bubbles within bubbles, building catapults or separating out colours using chromatography.

The theme for Science Week was **Decoding the Universe – Explore the Unknown with Nature's Hidden Language**. We decoded some of the universe in our backyard and collected data at Yakamia Creek. The most prevalent weed that we recorded was Taylorina. This is an imported species from South Africa. We also saw Blackberry, Watsonia and Sydney Wattle.

When we were birdwatching we found that it was hard to identify the little birds but we did see some Common Bronzewings, Australian Ringnecks, Red Wattlebirds and New Holland Honeyeaters. We even saw some Red Capped Parrots. Classes that had the magnifying glasses out spied ants, spiders with their egg sacs and even a Red Legged Weevil.

We can't wait to collect data at the creek again!


They have stepped into the role with determination and independence and I look forward to working with them for the rest of the year.


