In Weeks 6 and 7, our school celebrated **Indonesian Independence Day**, which falls on 17 August each year. This important day marks Indonesia's proclamation of independence in 1945 and is celebrated across the country with ceremonies, cultural performances and traditional games.

To mark the occasion, our students took part in a variety of fun activities that gave them an insight into Indonesian culture. They enjoyed playing traditional games such as **balap kelereng** (marble-onspoon race) and **lomba estafet tepung** (flour relay). These lively games brought plenty of laughter and teamwork to the celebrations!















Students also sampled some popular Indonesian foods, including the muchloved *kerupuk* (crispy rice crackers), which were a big hit!



The celebration was a wonderful opportunity for our students to learn about and appreciate the culture of our close neighbour, Indonesia, while practising language skills and enjoying a sense of community spirit.

Science News

This term students have been learning from the Earth and Space Sciences strand. Yr 1s have been covering the water cycle, Yr 2s are learning about Earth in the solar system and the Yr 3s have been learning about rocks and minerals.

Did you know that all our water is the same water that has been around for millions of years? It keeps getting circulated as part of the **water cycle.** We have done experiments to see how rain falls on different surfaces and did a great dance learning about water.









We are loving **rocks and minerals** in Year 3. Rocks can tell all different stories and some rocks are so interesting that people go to visit them. Maybe you know some famous rocks? We got really lucky as Mrs Dixon brought in some of her rocks from her collection at home. We even got to look at some tektites - they're what can happen when a meteorite hits earth. Thanks Mrs Dixon!







In Year 2 we have looked at the **earth in the solar system**, the **phases of the moon** and now **shadows**.

A shadow is an absence of light and can change size during the day depending on where the sun is in the sky!
